Mikids English Language Age 5 years Part 1: Level 1 - Lesson 9 Listening, Speaking skills and Writing Skills. Storyline: Elly and Elf



A. Listening Skill

- 1. Open up the programme.
- 2. You will need to run through the story yourself first
- 3. Go straight to the story page by page.

B. Speaking skills

- 1. Pause Pic #1. Listen.
- 2. Ask: What is the title of the story?
- 3. Pause Pic #2. Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 4. Ask: What animal is this picture? What is the name of the elephant?
- 5. Pause Pic #3, Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 6. Ask: What kind of elephant is Elly? Where does Elly work? Discuss
- 7. Pause Pic #4
- 8. Ask: What did Elly ask? Can you guess? Discuss
- 9. Pause Pic #5 Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 10. Ask: What did Elly say? Who is Elf? What is Elf? Discuss Elf through internet pictures.
- 11. Pause Pic #6. Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 12. Ask: What is Elf going to do? Discuss
- 13. Pause Pic #7. Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation,
- 14. Ask: What did Elly ask? Can you juggle eggs? Discuss
- 15. Ask: What do you think you can try to juggle? Discuss
- 16.Fun Activity

 Carry out a fun activity with your child juggling some balls



C. Speaking Skills - Words. Vocabulary recognition. Listen, Say and Recognize

- 1. Listen to the 4 vocabularies and look at the pictures about twice.
- 2. Turn off sound of the gadget. Pause at every picture.
- 3. Tell your child to say the word. Do it about three times.
- 4. Rerun without sound, pause at each page and cover the picture
- 5. Tell your child to recognise and say the word.
- 6. Praise your child for every word said correctly.

D. Speaking Skills - Comprehension Practice. Q&A

- 1. Pause at Q1
- 2. Give time to your child to answer
- 3. Continue than pause at Q2.
- 4. Give time to your child to answer
- 5. Try to ensure that your child answers in a full sentence and correct vocabulary order.







Part 1

A. Listening and Speaking Skills - Blending letter sounds - CVC

- 1. Open up the programme.
- 2. Component will auto run.
- 3. Parents please view the whole component first,
- 4. It is divided into 1) Word Letter blend 2) Reader text
 - 3) Reader sentences 4) Comprehension

Working with your child: Learning to blend letters into 3 letter sound words.

- 5. Look and listen to the introduction of p/a/d/ pad. PAUSE
- 6. Replay this page.
- 7. Tell your child to point and sound the letters and say the word.
- 8. Look and listen to the introduction of /m/a/d/ mad. PAUSE
- 9. Replay this page.
- 10.Tell your child to point and sound the letters and say the word
- 11. Look and listen to the introduction of /d/o/t/ dot. PAUSE
- 12. Replay this page.
- 13.Tell your child to point and sound the letters and say the word
- 14. Write out the letter one at a time and tell your child to sound and say the word
- 15. Do it for all the words a few times till your child is familiar.

Part 2 B. Listening and Speaking Skills - Reading text

- 1. Forward the programme to the page of the book with sentences.
- 2. Tell your child to look and listen to the sentences.
- 3. Run the page twice.
- 4. Run the page again but turn off the sound.
- 5. Tell your child to read as the words change colour.



- 6. The final round tell your child to point to the words and read.
- 7. Do this for all the sentences in the book picture.
- 8. Now rewind the programme backward to the picture with the full text.
- 9. Tell your child to attempt to read with you prompting along.
- 10. Carry out skill activities with your child.
 - 1. Look at the words 'men', 'pet and 'net'. Tell your child to sound blend the letters.
 - 2. Write the words that are in green on the screen onto a paper and tell your child to look and read.
- 11. Forward the programme to the part with question and answers.
- 12. Pause at the first question.
- 13. Ask your child for the answer.
- 14. Check by playing the programme again.
- 15. Ensure that your child answer in a full text.
- 16. Continue the same method for question 2.

C. Listening and Writing Skills.

- Refer Mikids Text book L1 Page 34 and 35
 Ask your School principal for a page copy if your child don't have the book.
- 2. Follow the instructions and do accordingly.




