Mikids English Language is a systematic friendly learning resource that is engaging through a variety of learning activities.



A. Listening Skill

- 1. Open up the programme.
- 2. Story will auto run.
- 3. Listen to the story.
- 4. Pause and asked the child "Do you understand?"
- 5. Click 'Story' on the above icon. Listen to the story again.
- 6. Ask: What is it about?
- 7. Give time to child to "talkabout" the story in his/her own understanding from her listening skill.



B. Speaking skills

- 1. Click button #1. Listen.
- 2. Ask: What is the title of the story?
- 3. Click button #3. Listen.Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 4. Ask: What is the name of the horse?
- 5. Click button #4. Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 6. Ask: What kind of horse is it?
- 7. Click button #5, #6, Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 8. Ask: What did Henry say?
- 9. Ask: How many legs does Henry have?
- 10. Ask: Can you count?
- 11. Ask: What about you? How many legs do you have? Discuss
- 12.Ask:Do you know of anything around our house that has 2 legs like Henry? Discuss
- 13. Otherwise ask: Do you know of anything that has 2 legs? Discuss
- 14. Click button #7. Listen. Repeat the sentence with emphasis on pronunciation and intonation.
- 15. Ask: What can Henry do?
- 16. Ask: Can you pretend to gattop i ke Deary? Discuss
- 17. Ask: Can all the other animals gallop? Discuss
- 18. Click button #8. Look at the picture.
- 19. Ask: What do you think the boy is doing? Discuss
- 20. Ask: w do you think the boy feels? Discuss

C. Conclusion: Language memory skill

Timeline: About Henry the horse

Ask:

- 1. What is the name of the horse?
- 2. What did is the colour of the horse?
- 3. What does the horse have?
- 4. What can the horse do?
- 5. What does people do with a horse?



Part 2: Listening and Speaking Skills Song

A. Listening Skill

- 1. Click **Song** on the top icon
- 2. Listen to the song.
- 3. Mother and child Listen and hum the tune,
- 4. Click **Lyric** on the top icon.
- 5. Listen to the lyric twice.

B. Speaking Skill

- 1. Turn off speaker and encourage child to say the lyric with mother prompting along.
- 2. Do it twice.
- 3. Turn on speaker, mother and child try to sing along with the lyric.
- 4. Ensure the pronunciation and location of vocabulary during the singing.
- 5. Mother can encourage the child to enjoy the action when singing.
